AHC has returned \$538,000 to Arlington County's Affordable Housing Investment Fund (AHIF) this year. The AHIF program provides low-interest, secondary loans to encourage the development of affordable housing in Arlington County. In the last five years, 11 of AHC's projects have participated in the program.
